

#### 9th Grade Schedule

- Freshmen have 8 classes and lunch.
  - Algebra I or Geometry
  - Biology
  - World History II
  - English I
  - Foreign Language (Spanish or Italian)
  - Physical Education & Health
  - Two Electives

#### Required Courses & Credits

- In addition to the required courses, with electives you must have 125 credits to graduate high school.
- Each full year course is worth 5 credits, half year 2.5 credits.
- Freshmen are scheduled to take 35-40 credits.
- If you pass your classes and stay on track you will have more than enough credits to graduate.
- Failed classes must be repeated.

#### Hallway & PE Lockers

#### Hallway Lockers

- Located by your homeroom.
- If you want to lock your locker, you can purchase your own lock.
- Locks are encouraged.
- Plan locker stops based on class location.
- Gym Lockers: Locks can be used during gym, but only during the period. They must be removed each day.

#### Lunch

- Lunch period on schedule (B, C or D)
- Bring lunch or buy lunch
  - Cash or preload money onto student account
  - Lunch account accessed with student ID#
- No food deliveries allowed
- All students can apply for the Free/Reduced Lunch Program
  - Applications available on Genesis.



#### Attendance Policy

- Absences Loss of Credit
  - 15 full year, 7 half year, 5 marking period
  - 3 unexcused tardies to a class = an absence to that class
- Loss of credit means you must retake the class

# Can I change my classes?

# How is high school different from middle school?

### How do I know who my teachers are?

Your teachers are listed on your schedule.

You can join as many clubs as you like.

# How do we sign up for clubs?

Club sign up will take place this fall. You can sign up for clubs in the commons on the club bulletin board.

If you would like to start your own club you must create a proposal, find a teacher advisor and submit your proposal to Mrs. Hasselberger.

### When will we get our schedules?

You all have access to your schedules on Genesis.

A parent must complete required forms on the Genesis Parent Portal before you will gain access to your Genesis account.

#### Where do we enter the school?

Students enter through the main entrance (Door 1) or through the South Gym entrance (Door 19)

If you are getting a ride to school, plan to be here before 7:40 AM to avoid getting stuck in traffic

#### Share Time Students

For students who are attending Pamus Tech half day, you will attend Paramus in the morning and will then be bussed back to RPHS for your afternoon classes.

You can participate in RPHS sports and clubs!

#### Do we have gym uniforms?
